POSITION OUTLOOK FOR 2010

QUARTERBACKS - In '08 SFA ret'd QB Jeremy Moses who threw for 1,253 (62%, 6-7) while splitting time in '07. Moses beat out C Mich transfer Duane Brooks, who moved to WR. Moses blossomed in the new spread offense and in his first full ssn as the starter setting multiple SFA and SLC records throwing for 4,026 (59%, 41-20). In '09 he led the FCS passing for 4,124 (68.0%, 40-21) and was the SLC Co-POY and returns for his final season. Dalton Williams returns for his third ssn as the backup after throwing for 344 (73.5%, 4-1) in '09.

RUNNING BACKS - SFA had to replace their top 4 rushers in '08 but added JC Tyrone Ross (PS#297JC). Ross started 8 of the L/9 but was just #3 (172, 3.8). RB Vincent Pervis started 1 and had 226 (5.3) while RB Cornel Tarrant started the final 3 and led with 540 (5.7). Tarrant departed but both Ross and Pervis returned in '09. Pervis led with 919 (6.0) and had 177 (7.1) rec yds and was 2nd tm SLC. Ross had 388 (4.9) with 95 (4.5) rec yds. They lose their top 2 rushers TY in Pervis and Ross. Their top returnees are #3 Romonte Hampton (324, 4.6) and #4 QB Moses (43, 0.9). Rice transfer rFR Broderick Jackson (PS#187DB) was the #2 RB after spring and should split the carries.

RECEIVERS - In '08 SFA moved in QB Brooks, ret'd an '06 starter (RS '07) and their top 4 rec led by WR Dominique Edison (582, 10.6). Edison led again with 1,016 (15.2, 18 TD) and was 1st tm SLC but departed as a #6 DC. In '09 they lost #4 rec WR Tyrel Williams (461, 11.0) but they ret'd 3 of their top 5 including Brooks who was the SLC NCOY with 863 in 10 gms in '08, Contrevious Parks (591, 12.1) and Aaron Rhea (386, 9.9). They were #1 in the SLC in passing off for a 2nd straight ssn and improved from #3 to #1 in the FCS in passing. They lose 3 of their top 4 rec TY in 1st tm SLC Brooks (1,076, 9.1, 6 TD), 2nd tm SLC HB Parks (464, 10.3, 5 TD) and Rhea (388, 4.9), who led with 11 rec TD's. The top returnees are led by Gralyn Crawford (785, 15.4, 7 TD), Cordell Roberson (398, 19.0, 4 TD) and Brandon Scott (273, 11.4, 5 TD). They also add Louisiana Tech transfer WR Houston Tuminello (PS#144) who had 193 rec yds (8.8) the last 2 yrs.

OFFENSIVE LINE - The OL lost 4 str's in '08 but added 2 JC's and LSU transfer C Maxwell Holmes (PS#85). With the switch in offense the rushing numbers declined for a 2nd straight year (4.3 to 3.6 to 3.4 ypc) but the sack tfl dropped by 4 (25, 4.0%) despite the huge increase in pass att. In '09 they ret'd 4 str's led by C Holmes and improved their ypc to 4.3 ypc and allowed just 14 sks (3.8%). They must replace 1st tm SLC LT Karl Glimp and 2nd tm SLC C Holmes. They ret 3 str's in RT George Bias, LG Austin Wright and RG John Steel. They move up 2 big Soph lettermen in RT Corey Dickerson (6'8" 306) and C Fitseula Partsch (6'4" 300).

DEFENSIVE LINE - The DL ret'd 2 str's in '08 incl DE Tim Knicky (#4 tklr, who led with 15 tfl. The rush D improved by 59 ypg (ypc 5.5 to 4.0) but still finished #8 SLC in rush D though the sk tfl jumped from just 11 to a SLC best 32. In '09 the DL ret'd 3 str's led by 1st tm SLC Knicky (#6 tklr) who led with 12 sks (20.5 tfl). They added 2 JC's in Jacob Fincher (PS#423) and Sean Warren (PS#380JC). They improved to #2 in rush D allowing just 3.3 ypc and the D again led the SLC in sks with 42. They lose both starting DE's in AA and SLC Co-DPOY Knicky (#10 tklr, 12.5 sk) and Andre Hicks (#12 tklr, 10 tfl). They ret 2 str's in 2nd tm SLC DT Kenneth Charles (#8 tklr, 9 sks), who moves to DE, and DT Warren (#11 tklr, 4.5 tfl) along with backups DT Weekend Saurit (19 tkl) and DE Fincher (17 tkl, 4.5 sks). They also add in JC DE Tyler Francis (PS#461JC).

LINEBACKERS - The LB unit ret'd 2 str's in '08 and moved in Off starter Joe Savoie. In '09 they had to replace starting LB Terrance Nurse (#5 tklr) along with Savoie who had 50 tkl as a backup. The unit ret'd AA Jabar Williams (#1 tklr, 6 tfl) and LB Derrick Choice (#2, 10.5 tfl) and moved in '07 starting FS Devin Ducote (#2 tklr in '07), who RS in '08. They ret all 3 str's in AA LB Williams (#2 tklr, 9.5 tfl), LB Choice (#4 tklr, 6.5 tfl) and 2nd tm SLC LB Ducote (#1 tklr, 12.5 tfl) who led the SLC with 137 tkl. They also ret top backup LB Ryan Epperson (#9 tklr).

DEFENSIVE BACKS - In '08 the secondary ret'd 2 str's led by SS Chad Haynes (#1 tklr in '07) as they lost starting FS Ducote to injury prior to the ssn. SFA dropped from #2 SLC to #5 in pass D allowing a poor 24-9 ratio. In '09 they lost CB Ivan Delgado (12 tkl) who started the last 4 but ret'd 5 who comb for 43 str's in '08 incl FS Cody Barlow (#3 tklr) and SS Haynes (#4) and added a JC. They improved from #5 to #4 in pass D allowing a 19-11 ratio. They must replace 1st tm SLC S Barlow (#3 tklr, 3 int). They ret 3 str's in SLC NCOY CB Andre Banks (#6 tklr, 2 int, 6 pbu), CB Josh Aubrey (#7 tklr,

2 int, 6 pbu) and SS Haynes (#5 tklr, 2 int, 7 pbu) along with backup S Jordan Aubrey (#13 tklr) who looks fill the open spot.

SPECIAL TEAMS - In '08 SFA ret'd their top KR and K. In '09 they ret P Drew Nelson (40.6) along with top KR Pervis (23.2) and PR Brooks (8.6). They lost K Cory Long (9 of 13 FG, all 4 misses from 40+). This year they lose 2nd tm SLC K Evan Engwall (20 of 28 FG) and their top 2 KR's and top 2 PR's. They ret 2nd tm SLC P Drew Nelson who avg 41.5 ypp but add in UTEP transfer K Logan Barrett (PS#74) who hit 13-18 FG in '09.

COACHES - HC JC Harper returns for his 6th ssn here and 4th as HC. OC Shannon Dawson and DC David Gibbs both return for their 3rd seasons.

FORECAST - The Lumberjacks offense ret'd 9 starters LY and they were in the 2nd year of the spread offense. They improved from #5 SLC to #2 in scoring and from #5 to #1 in total offense. The offense returns just 5 starters but is led by '09's Co-POY QB Moses, who returns for his Sr ssn, and also added an FBS transfer. The defense returned 9 starters and 8 of their top 10 tklr's including their top 4. They improved from #8 to #2 in scoring and #7 to #2 in total defense. The defense returns 8 starters and 15 of their top 18 tklr's including 8 of their top 9. The Lumberjacks made a big leap in '09 after 4 straight losing seasons and won a share of the SLC crown. By virtue of their win over Co-Champ McNeese, SFA won the conf's automatic bid into the playoffs but were smacked by eventual runner-up Montana, in the quarterfinals but still finished ranked #10. SFA will again be in the hunt for the SLC crown and how well the offense comes together will determine how far they will go.
