

KANSAS JAYHAWKS

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF

OFFENSE

Off Coordinator/QBs: Ed Warinner, 3rd year

Warinner has 25 yrs of college coaching exp. This will be his 3rd year as the OC/QB cch, but his 2nd stint at KU as he was the OL/Run Game Coordinator in '03-'04. He spent the '05 & '06 ssns with the same responsibilities at Illinois guiding the #1 ranked Big Ten rushing off in '06 (189 ypg, best S/73). Warinner was on the AF staff in 2000-'02 and spent 13 ssns with Army while also making stops at Michigan St ('85 & '86) & Akron (1984). He was a standout player at Mount Union College from 1980-'84.

Running Backs/ST: Louie Matsakis, 5th year

Matsakis begins his 3rd ssn as RB's coach and 2nd stint with KU as in 2004-'05 worked here in many areas. He took over in '07 for Mosley who resigned for health reasons. Matsakis spent 2006 coaching ST at Capital and in 2008 added that to his duties at KU. He also was at Texas St-San Marcos in '03 and Texas Tech from 2000-'02.

Wide Receivers: David Beaty, 2nd year

Beaty begins his 2nd ssn as the WR cch after spending 2006-'07 pulling the same duties at Rice. Prior to Rice Beaty was a HS HC posting a 33-11 record from '02-'05. Beaty was a 4 yr starter (WR) for Lindenwood College.

Tight Ends/Asst OL: Brandon Blaney, 8th year

Blaney (also Recruiting Coordinator) begins his 8th season with Kansas. Blaney was a student/graduate assistant for seven yrs at Youngstown State (4), Oklahoma (2) and Ohio State (1). He assisted with the OL for the Sooners when Mangino was OC and was one of his first hires after Mangino got the head coaching job here.

Offensive Line: John Reagan, 5th year

Reagan starts his 5th year here and is also the Run Game Coordinator. He was the OL Coach at Air Force in '03 & '04 (also assisted with some ST duties). He was at Temple for 3 yrs (1 year at OL, 2 years at DL) and at Army and Pennsylvania each for 1 season (TE/OT's). He was a three year starter at Syracuse

DEFENSE

Co-Def Coordinator/Safeties: Clint Bowen, 9th year

Almost all of Bowens entire coaching career has been here at Kansas and he has worn a variety of hats. He was a DB with the Jayhawks and his 114 tackles in 1993 is still #3 by a DB all-time. He was a graduate assistant for 2 years, then in succeeding years was the Assistant Director of Football Operations, the TE's coach, the RB's coach and the safeties coach from 2003 to the present, being the special teams coordinator from 2001-'05. Bowen added another job 4 years ago with the Co-Defensive Coordinator position. In 2008 he was the full-time DC, but this year will share those duties once again.

Co-Def Coordinator/Linebackers: Bill Miller, 1st year

Miller enters his first year at Kansas as the Co-DC and LBs coach. He spent the '08 season as the Louisville LB coach and was promoted to DC at the start of 2009, but elected to join Mangino's staff. Miller has 31 years of coaching experience. He has been a DC at Nevada, Oklahoma St, Miami (Fl), Michigan St, Arizona St and Western Michigan. Miller also was a LB cch at Florida and made stops at Texas-Arlington, Drake and Minnesota.

Defensive Line: Tom Sims, 1st year

Sims enters his 1st ssn at KU after 4 years as the Illinois DL coach. He was the DL coach at Minnesota from 2001-'04. Sims coached the DL at WKU from 1997-'99 and than on to Eastern Michigan for a year. Sims played at Western Michigan and than transferred to Pitt were he recorded 142 tkls & 12.5 sks in 2 ssns ('88-'89). After College he played in the NFL for 7 yrs with the KC Chiefs (1990-'92 & '96) and the Indianapolis Colts (1993-'94).

Cornerbacks: Je'Ney Jackson, 5th year

Jackson will enter his 3rd season as a full-time KU coach with the CB's after spending the '05 & '06 seasons as the Jayhawks Assistant Strength Coach. He was a All-WAC CB at Wyoming and a four-year letterwinner from 1994-'97.
